## FUNDING FOR RAIZOR CHAIR SUCCESSFUL

At the November Netheravon Showcase Event I introduced the Raizor Chair, which is used by first responders to help patients who have fallen to be lifted from the floor.

I was looking for funding to purchase one for Netheravon and the surrounding villages. Mary Towle, Clerk to Netheravon Parish Council, helped me to complete the application to the Stonehenge Area Board and Ian Blair Pilling, Graham Wright and David Burke supported my application. I have now been informed that I have received the full amount of £3000 to purchase a chair and I am delighted and would like to give massive thanks to them all for their support.

I have been given a loan chair whilst I wait for the village Raizor Chair to arrive and I have already used it to help a patient off the floor. I am hoping that, instead of waiting for an ambulance to attend, we will be able to get patients up off of the floor, as sometimes people need to go to hospital just because of the length of time they have been lying there.

This is definitely a good asset for the village. The First Responder boss, David Wilmot, has informed us that they are also hoping to open up recruiting in the spring for Community First Responders. If anyone is interested in becoming one. I would be happy to talk to them about it or, alternatively, just look on NHS jobs.

## **Fittleton cum Haxton Parish Council**

The parish councillors have been busy working to ensure the parish is kept in good order and any issues are dealt with or passed to someone who can deal with them.

The Christmas lighting event and parish gathering was well supported and we were lucky with the weather. The raffle raised £74 and the evening was an opportunity to catch up with neighbours before the Christmas season was in full swing.

A Speed Indicator Device was loaned to Haxton by Durrington council. It was requested by residents following a series of pet deaths along the road leading from The Pound to the red bridge. A request for match funding to purchase a device was put to Stonehenge Area Board. That request has been successful and we will soon be in a position to place an order for a permanent device.

Work is also underway to replace the finger post on The Pound. A new post will be built in time for unveiling for the Queen's Jubilee celebrations.

Finally, the parish council voted unanimously to co-opt Paul Cranch to fill the vacancy that has been in place since May 2021. The parish council is now fully staffed again and we welcome the energy and experience that Paul brings to the role.

### Good News!

At the Netheravon Parish Council Meeting of 13<sup>th</sup> January 2022, the Parish Council voted to reduce the precept for the year 2022/2023 by approximately 10%. This has been possible by reducing the amount which will be given, with their agreement, to the Phoenix Hall and the Newsletter. The Jubilee project to provide adult exercise equipment in the Millennium Park is being paid for by grants from the Lottery and the Stonehenge Area Board.

### Best Advent Window

The Advent Window won by Kim Sheppard at 109 High Street. This advent window was exceptional. The standard of advent windows around the village was very high this year and everyone enjoyed walking around the village spotting the windows through December. Thanks very much to Graeme Rasdell Lawes for organising this very worthwhile event.

## Blasts from the Past

In these days of stress, with Covid, stabbings, climate change and the like, the "old times" look pretty good.

I suppose the last major event to affect us was World War 2, but even that didn't seem to restrict us as much. Rationing, blackout, carry a gas mask everywhere etc. In the country we were fortunate food-wise. An abundance of rabbits, people kept chickens. I remember a man keeping a pig in his garden. Neighbours helped with scraps to feed it and getting a bit of pork eventually.

We all built air raid shelters in the garden. Never used of course. The only bomb dropped was at Mileball. Netheravon airfield packed with gliders before D Day and American troops camped out at Beeches Barn are a couple of memories.

The village has changed so much. Vicarage Gardens estate now stands where the old vicarage and the gardens stood, where village fetes were held. The school opposite has gone, as are most shops. We had Post Office, Bruce White grocers, Tom Carter (cobbler), Butcher Bradley (his son rode for Swindon Speedway). Mrs Andrews vegetables, Mr Douse saddler, Stevie Hiscock with her bicycle spares, Pinchens baker and groceries, Margaret down the hill with all sorts, Vera hairdresser, Sammy hairdresser, Hoppy Hopkins radio shack at the bottom of Court Farm, Pethick newsagent, Tom Drew with garage and petrol pumps.

Everything seemed so much more easy going then. People made their own entertainment visiting each other's houses for cards or games and there was the Working Men's Club and Legion. Summer seemed longer - warm days in the harvest fields. More clear-cut seasons with harder winters and snow most years. Long walks on a Sunday afternoon - a bit of river poaching when Frank Sawyer wasn't about. Out playing in the woods all day, building rival huts etc.

Maybe it's because we have so much worldwide information that all seems to be doom and gloom these days, but hopefully it will get better.

I remember the Big Freeze of 1962/63 very well I had just left school on the Friday before Christmas that year and started work at Pinchens the Bakers and Groceries store the next day.

On the Boxing Day I went to Salisbury to the pictures with some friends. Halfway through the film an announcement was made that the road on Salisbury flats was closed by snow. If you want to go north there was a bus leaving in about 15 minutes from the bus station, going through the Woodford valley which be the last bus out of Salisbury. As we went outside the snow was blowing a blizzard- we managed to catch the bus and got home safely.

The next morning I had to go to work and woke up to the scene of snow which was very deep. I managed to get to work where I was greeted with the vans and shop covered with snow. We had to clear as much of the snow to get the vans on the road to deliver bread and groceries to the customers. It was a struggle. We could not deliver far as we found out that the main road was blocked.

Later in the day we were told that Netheravon was cut off from the outside, also that there were 20-foot drifts covering all of Salisbury Plain. The snow was still lying on the ground and on the roads until the end of March. With this the temperature stayed below freezing all this time.
