Fittleton cum Haxton Annual Parish Meeting – Chair’s Report 10/05 2022

This year has been a busy one, concentrating on improvements around the villages.

There have been repairs to the fences at the allotments in June. In July, the bench on The Pound was fully refurbished and is once again a place of rest for locals and visitors.

The defibrillators have been kept up to date with new pads. These life-saving machines are located in Fittleton and Haxton and are available to ensure residents have access to them whenever they may be needed.

Councillors have worked hard at their various responsibilities. Cllr Jago and Cllr Gowman have had a busy year with a number of planning applications, some more complex than others. Cllr Vaughan-Edwards has continued to oversee the work of the parish steward and has also worked with the Jubilee Committee, including assisting with the Lighting of the Beacon arrangements. Cllr Symes has been busy managing the allotments and recruiting replacements for those that have become vacant. She has also represented the parish council on the Phoenix Hall committee. Cllr Morgan has responsibility for Transport and Highways and he ensures that any issues are addressed on behalf of the parish council.

The Tidy Day was well supported and many residents turned out to ensure that our street were clean and tidy. It was fun and a great opportunity to catch up with our neighbours. The next **Tidy Day** is scheduled for **29th May, 10am to 12 noon**. It falls just before the Jubilee celebrations and is a chance to get everything in good order for the celebration weekend.

The Christmas get together was well-supported and the mince pies and Gluhwein were well received. In January 2022, the parish council succeeded in gaining 50% funding for the Speed Indicator Device (SID), located on the road from Haxton to Netheravon. This followed a series of incidents where pets were killed by speeding cars. The device has had an impact on slowing traffic down as it moves between Netheravon and Haxton.

The latest improvement is the replacement of the finger post on The Pound, Haxton. The previous finger post had rotted and was in poor condition. A replacement was commissioned by the parish council and has been erected on The Pound

Fittleton Cum Haxton parish council commissioned a replacement and managed to secure a willing and very able person to make a faithful replacement.

Stephen Turner, the person who constructed the finger post, accompanied by a colleague, came to Haxton and erected the new post. They worked hard but made it look easy. Every effort was made to produce a faithful replica and given the fact that we are about to celebrate the Queen’s Platinum Jubilee, Stephen even made a lead crown to sit atop of the post.

The Pound is a popular tourist resting place, where visitors and locals sit to eat their packed lunches or enjoy some moments of quiet reflection. The replacement of the finger posts will ensure that From the councillors and parishioners of Fittleton Cum Haxton, a huge “Thank You” to everyone involved in ensuring that our beautiful sign lives to direct locals and visitors for many years to come. A special thank you to councillor Graham Wright for sourcing the expertise and for taking the time to see the project through. When parishes support each other, great things can be achieved.

PCC Philip Wilkinson column

Increasing and improving the number ways my office, and Wiltshire Police, engage with communities is just one way to ensure Wiltshire has a police force which meets the needs of the people it serves.

We have to engage more with local communities and involve them in decision making, we simply have to excel at the basics. Slowly, this will have an impact and we will see an increase in our communities' trust that they are being heard and listened to.

Wiltshire Police is already making strides towards greater community engagement. We need to tell people who their local officers are as well as hearing when there has been great service or when there hasn't.

Making Wiltshire Safer has gone some way to bridge the gap between the police and the communities they serve. I believe it's not just about listening to those who shout the loudest, but also taking the time to meaningfully engage with those who feel they have limited influence.

This is where the Youth Commission plays such a crucial role, young people aged 14-25, are empowered to act as a critical friend to me and Wiltshire Police.

When it comes to young people, we do find that, even with the best intentions, services and initiatives are provided for them, instead of with them and we risk alienating the very people we want to help.

We are now in the process of recruiting new members for the Youth Commission and I urge you to consider encouraging young people to apply.

I recognise there may be some sceptics who think this is lip service and won't result in tangible action or change. But that is not, and will never be, my leadership style.

My core responsibility is to represent Wiltshire and Swindon's residents when it comes to police and crime matters. This is not a responsibility that I take lightly or will shy away from.
