#### **Changes to parking at Salisbury Hospital**

As of Monday February 6, patient and visitor car parks are controlled by Automatic Number Plate Recognition ANPR cameras, which capture vehicle registrations as you drive onto the hospital site. When you return to your vehicle, enter your vehicle registration number into the car park pay terminal, located inside the car park and pay for the time used. Payment can be made with cash, bank card, including contactless, or via **mobile phone app.** Payment machines do not give change.

#### **Grace period**

There is a 30-minute grace period for vehicles; this allows time to pick up and drop off items or people and the vehicle owner will not be charged. If they are getting close to the 30-minute mark, they are asked to please enter their vehicle registration number at a payment machine to be sure that they are within the time limit. Drivers can take advantage of several grace periods in a day as long as they are no longer than 30 minutes, i.e. they can drop off in the morning and pick up in the afternoon.

#### APCOA APP - Want to skip the queues?

Cashless parking is available.

- 1. Download the APCOA connect app on your mobile device
- 2. Enter the location code 2759
- 3. Select your vehicle, the app will display your entry time and auto calculate your tariff
- 4. Pay and then exit the car park

#### Free parking

The following groups of patients and visitors are entitled to free parking: Blue Badge holders

- Parking is free for holders of a valid Blue Badge.
- Please display your Blue Badge on your dashboard.
- Please register your Blue Badge on the APCOA Blue Badge Permit Portal ideally before you come to hospital. <a href="https://bluebadge.apcoa.co.uk/">https://bluebadge.apcoa.co.uk/</a>
- If you arrive at hospital before registering your Blue Badge, you can validate your free parking using the tablets at the Main Entrance Enquiries Desk or the Cashiers

Parents of children staying in hospital overnight

- Your parking is free if your child has to stay overnight in hospital.
- Please speak to the ward team caring for your child, who will validate your parking.

Regular outpatient attenders

Parking will be provided free to all outpatients who attend hospital for an appointment at least three times within a month and for an overall period of at least three months. Spring has almost sprung – and with it an unbelievably good new local biography. Monday the 20<sup>th</sup> of March marks the first day of Spring, and the launch of a local author's first book. *Unbelievable! A Working Country Life*, by Victoria Walsh, tells the story of Fittleton man Martin Aris.

Victoria met Martin seven years ago, when she and her partner Simon moved to the mill at Coombe, where Martin works as a river keeper. They've always loved hearing Martin's hilarious stories about country life: of a naughty little boy growing up in the 1950s & 60s Cotswolds, of moving to Wiltshire as a cheeky young farmer, and ending up a wise but still sparky river keeper. It was these stories and Martin's musings on nature and life, which sparked the idea for the book. However, this isn't any old countryside book: *Unbelievable!* contains not just wildlife but also 'the wild life' - poaching, punch-ups and more. It's also written phonetically, in Martin's own Cots-Wilts accent, and embellished with expletives. This definitely isn't the Queen's (or King's) English!

Unbelievable! has lots of local and historic interest, and it's supporting local businesses. The book has been produced by a Wiltshire publisher (Chalk Stream Books) and illustrated by a Wiltshire artist (Alex Crump). It's also supporting a good cause, as 10% of profits will be donated to The Angling Trust.

Victoria will be launching the book on the evening of the 20<sup>th</sup> of March at the Pewsey Heritage Centre (6-7.30pm). Please email <u>victoriawalsh.info@gmail.com</u> for information and (free) tickets. Places limited.

#### **Police and Crime Commissioner Philip Wilkinson**

My annual budget proposed a raise the amount of money you pay for the policing part of your council tax, known as the precept, by 6.2%.

For an average Band D household, that equates to £15 a year or £1.25 a month.

It's been a difficult decision to make and that's why it was important we consulted you.

Over 2,700 people responded to the survey. We also took it out across Swindon and Wiltshire to gather your feedback. I'd like to take this opportunity to thank you if you took the time to complete it.

54% of people who responded said they would be prepared to support a maximum rise but it's important to make clear why I asked you to support that option.

Without putting up the precept, Wiltshire Police would need to save over £4m in the next year. Even by increasing the precept, savings will be key but I'm confident this will happen at the same time as delivering a better service. We will put 32 extra police officers on the streets of Wiltshire, in addition to the new Uplift officers. We should have 1,189 police officers by the end of March this year – the highest number for quite some time.

I am constantly speaking to our local MPs and government ministers about the funding formula. We need a fairer system which provides our police force with the investment equal to forces similar to ours. By raising the precept, we can show we are playing our part in funding our police force and this puts us in a stronger position.

With more officers on our streets and a better use of our existing funds, I hope you will see an improvement in the service you receive and see value for money in the measures I've taken to make Wiltshire a safer place to live and work.
