Bank Holidays and Coronations

What a busy May we have! After a wonderfully long and faithful reign of Queen Elizabeth II, we begin May with the coronation of King Charles III... and another Bank Holiday to add to the early May one.

The coronation marks the formal beginning of King Charles' reign, and a fantastic opportunity for us all to come together as a community. After an unprecedented (I'm sure we haven't heard that word enough!) few years of social upheaval, chances to gather and connect in person are renewed precious opportunities. As a relative newcomer, I am looking forward to the chance to meet more people, and another moment to further understand everything that makes this community special.

The coronation has given us two early May Bank Holidays this year, the first of which we inherited from the Scots, something that melded international labour day and May Day celebrations. However, the late May Bank Holiday originates from our Christian tradition. Whit Monday is the day after Whitsunday, the time we celebrate the birth of the church. This Sunday is also called Pentecost, marking 50 days after Easter, and remembering when the Holy Spirit filled the disciples. The account in Acts 2 talks of a gale force wind sweeping through, and people who had gathered from all over the known world hearing each other speaking their own language. I love this example of God moving to create radical unity. Greater unity in our community is something I am sure we can all hope for.

Let's use the Bank Holidays this year, yes to cash in the 'double word scores' of making our annual leave go a bit further, but also to invest in the blessing we have of the people around us. We would love that to include you coming to spend time with us at church as we celebrate our birthday too, there might even be cake!


